

Home Reading Program

Dear Parents and Students:

We invite you to participate in our "Home Reading Program". Our purpose is to aid the development of good reading habits through practice, example, encouragement, and positive attitude toward reading.

How does the program work? Attached are the monthly calendar slips. The reading program will be conducted from October to March. Cut off the appropriate month and keep in a safe place. Each day the student reads the required time, he/she should mark the day on the calendar. Before turning in the reading slip, please make sure that it includes the student's name, grade, teacher's name and parent's signature. **Turn the reading slip in on time and only if you have read the required time.**

What are the requirements? Students in Kindergarten through 2nd grade must read or be read to for 15 minutes a day/20 days a month. Students in 3rd, 4th and 5th grade must read 30 minutes a day/20 days a month.

When are slips due? Students are responsible for turning in their slips by the due date, which is noted below. The students should turn in their slips to the teacher.

Prizes! Students who have read the required time will be rewarded with a Pizza Hut coupon and a prize each month. Students reading all 6 months (October-March) will be rewarded with a Grand Prize at the end of the school year.



Home Reading Program

Dear Teachers:

The Home Reading Program for 2015-2016 will begin in October. Please save and use the attached envelope to collect and return the Home Reading slips that the students turn in at the beginning of each month, please only send slips in the envelope. The due dates are on the back of your class manila envelope. On the due date to PTO, please put the envelope in the PTO mailbox on the dates listed below. Students have a one week grace period, where slips can be turned in before the PTO collects them from teachers.

Please send the packet home in the student's folder. Please take a moment to review with the students what they need to do to participate. For those of you not familiar with the program the procedure and requirements are listed below. Please make sure the student's name is on the slip before you send it down.

How does the program work? The Reading Program will be conducted from October through March. Each student will get a calendar to keep at home. Each day the child reads the required time, he/she should mark the calendar with an "X". Before turning in the slips please make sure the student's name, grade, teacher's name and parent's signature is filled in. They should turn in their slips on time and only if they have read at least 20 days.
PLEASE DO NOT TURN IN DUPLICATE SLIPS!!!

What are the requirements? Students in Kindergarten through 2nd grade must read or be read to for 15 minutes a day/20 days per month. Students in 3rd, 4th and 5th must read for 30 minutes a day/20 days per month.

When are the slips due? Students are responsible for turning in their slips to their teacher by the due date, which is noted below and on each calendar.
